### What is **jobsearch.gov.au**?

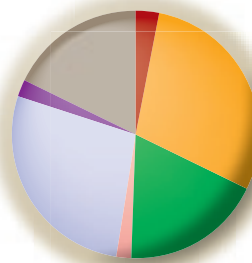

JobSearch has more than 60 000 registered job seekers looking for jobs in hospitality.

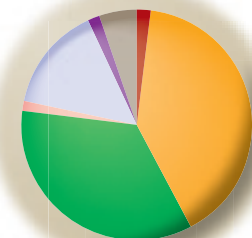
#### Hospitality job preferences of registered job seekers on JobSearch

## Why use JobSearch to find hospitality staff?

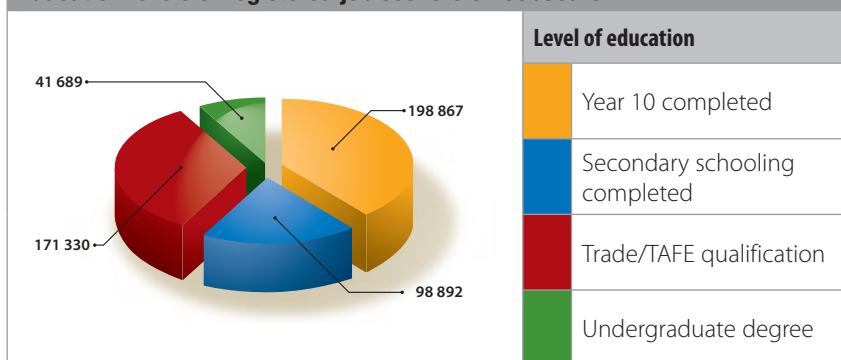

- > Almost half a million people work in hospitality.

- > Many hospitality jobs have low entry levels. Almost 60 per cent of workers do not hold post-school qualifications, making it a key entry point to the labour market.
- > The industry also provides good opportunities for part-time employment with almost half of the jobs part-time—the highest proportion for any industry.

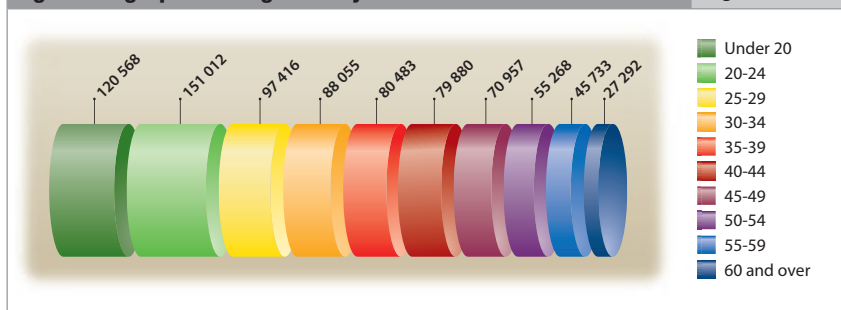

Education levels of registered job seekers on JobSearch



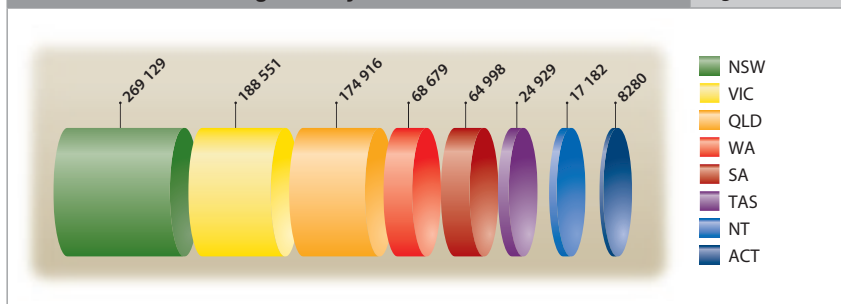
More than 300 000 job seekers registered on JobSearch had completed year 12 and/or post secondary qualifications including qualifications in hospitality.

The hospitality industry employs a high proportion of young workers, 33 per cent of registered job seekers on JobSearch are aged 25 years or less.
